What has <u>not</u> changed under NRS or NYRS?


- Educational Gain still the focus
 - Benchmark = 51%

- Emphasis on Post Testing
 - Benchmark = 70%



•Reports valid for BOTH NRS & NYRS

- Missing Key Demographics
- Invalid Test Scores
- Invalid Enrollment Dates
- Enrolled but Not Counted

What has changed?

Recording Social Security Numbers has become an important detail

- Not required to report
- If no SSN, program commits to following-up for outcomes manually and documenting in ASISTS

Follow-Up

- All Participants must be followed up on after exit
 - Those with SSN numbers in ASISTS will be submitted to the NYDOL Unemployment Database
 - Those with no social security number recorded in ASISTS must be followed up on manually!

- NRS: ALL Participants are followed up in the 2nd and 4th quarters after they exit
- NYRS: ALL Participants are followed up in the 2nd quarter after they exit

Follow-Up

- For programs following NRS regulations:
 - 2nd Quarter follow up:
 - Employment
 - Wages
 - 4th Quarter follow up:
 - Employment
- For Programs following NYRS policy:
 - 2nd Quarter follow up
 - Employment

Social Security Numbers

Follow Up Process

- Program makes decision to collect SSNs from participants
- For those recorded, ASISTS will pull when the follow up timeline arrives
- Match will be made with UI database
- Percent of match is credited back to the program
- NO individual participant data will be communicated back to the program
- Programs must follow up manually on all participants with no SSN recorded

• Follows NYS and Federal Assessment Policy


Auto Exiting

• ASISTS exits participants after 3 consecutive months of no attendance

What has changed under NRS and NYRS?

When and How does a student's HSE Diploma count as an Outcome:

- HSE is achieved within the fiscal year (June 30th)
- Program is responsible for following up with the student
- Student must enter employment or postsecondary training within one year after exit

 - POP MSG Achievement by EFL (Table 4)

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
What has changed under NRS and NYRS?

- HSE Attainment
 - New Policy from NYSED
 - ASISTS will exchange data with NYSED HSE office
 - Match = Prep Code + First Name + Last Name + DOB
 - Diplomas will only count when a valid T-TAF has been submitted when the student is referred to the TASC test
 - NOTE: If an ALE funded program does not have an HSE Prep Code, apply for one!



New EFLs

New Educational Functioning Level Descriptors for English as a Second Language (ESL)

Introduction

In the National Reporting System for Adult Education (NRS), the Educational Functioning Level (EFL) descriptors are intended to guide teaching and assessment for adult learners. The descriptors for English as a second language (ESL) are divided into six educational functioning levels: Beginning ESL Literacy, Low Beginning ESL, High Beginning ESL, Low Intermediate ESL, High Intermediate ESL, and Advanced ESL. The descriptors do not provide a complete or comprehensive delineation of all of the skills at any given level but rather provide a description of the most critical concepts and skills for the level.
