

## Comprehension Scoring Chart

The chart below lists the Secondary A and B reading passages from the *Bader Reading and Language Inventory, 7th Edition*. See Bader page 29 for a complete list of passages and levels to use for either Fluency assessment or Comprehension assessment. Do not use the same passage for both assessments. Ex. if you use “Volcanoes” (6SA) for Fluency, use “Driver’s Licenses” (6SB) for comprehension.

The number of answers correct are used to determine whether or not to continue with the next higher level passage or go down a level to find the highest level passage where the student is comprehending at 75% or higher. Taken from Bader, page 46.
